### **ONLINE VS PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS:**

TRACS is accepting Online entries for this trial through the AKC Agility Online Entry Service. Go to [www.akc.org/AgilityEntry](http://www.akc.org/AgilityEntry) and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper entries will be as follows: Online entry: 200 per day; Paper entries: 500 per day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or the paper limits accordingly.

**ONLINE ENTRY REFUND POLICY: Online convenience fees will not be refunded for any reason.**

### **MURIETA RELEASE FORM – REQUIRED**

Murieta Equine Complex requires all competitors to sign a release waiver in order to participate in events at MEC. There is a pdf at the end of this premium that you must complete and return with your entry. Per MEC direction, forms sent to other clubs/trial secretaries no longer count.

- There will not be equipment familiarization at this trial.
- Move ups will be accepted until **6 pm Monday, December 26, 2022**. Day to day move ups will be accepted providing a move up form is completed and turned into the Trial Secretary on site within 15 minutes of the end of each day's trial.

- **ENTRY FEES (PER DOG, PER DAY): \$18 for each class.**
- **JUNIOR HANDLER ENTRY FEES (PER DOG PER DAY): \$9.00**
- **SHOW SITE:** This show will be held outdoors under cover on dirt. Ring dimensions: each ring will be 100 wide' by 100' long.

#### **AWARDS**

- Rosettes or flat ribbons will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place dogs with qualifying scores in each regular and preferred class and jump height.
- Prizes valued between \$2 and \$5 will be awarded to all dogs placing first through fourth in their class/jump height.
- Green Qualifying flat ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score.
- Special Rosettes will be awarded to any dog completing a title or earning a "Double Q" from the Masters classes.
- Special Award for any dog completing a MACH/PACH/AGCh. If you anticipate you may complete one of these amazing milestones at our trial, PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary.

#### **SPECIAL COMPETITION!!**

- o TRACS is offering a "High Scoring Novice" award. There will be six awards:
  - Novice A, B and P, Small and Large divisions in each
  - Who is eligible to compete for the Award?
    - Any dog who starts their TRACS trial series in Nov A/B/P Standard and/or JWW. The second class may be entered at any level
  - How will the award be calculated?
    - The winners will be determined by cumulative seconds under standard course time (adjusted for faults) for qualifying runs in Standard, JWW and T2B for the first three days of the trial.

### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

A **separate entry form** must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Wait List: Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials closing date. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 11:30 pm on December 17, 2022. Any entries withdrawn by 6:00 pm on December 23, 2022 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund less a \$5 processing fee will be issued to the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on December 23, 2022 will receive a full refund.

- This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.
- Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.
- Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or have anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.
- Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and must list "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) for the breed name on the entry form. No other breed description may be used to identify a mixed breed entry. Additionally, the exhibitor must provide their AKC Canine Partners listing number on the entry form and check-mark "AKC No."
- Running order will be determined by a random draw. Handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.

- No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope.
- **EXCEPT IN A WAIT LIST SITUATION, there will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or handler as confirmed by a veterinarian's or doctor's letter/email. In these cases, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified in writing (email is acceptable, but **MUST** be sent return receipt to confirm we did receive it) prior to the trial.** Bitches in season will be refunded their full entry fee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- No entry fee will be refunded if this trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Entry fee overpayments of less than \$25 will not be refunded.
- **Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry-PLEASE PRINT or use entry form included in the premium or available as stand alone file on the TRACS website;** illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial.
- **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.** The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a "cash only" basis.
- Handlers of all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog, prior to the start of a class.
- A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring. No umbrellas permitted on course during walk throughs.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fee paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors, while competing, must wear appropriate/proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet. .
- Please clean up after your dog. Let's show them that "Dog People" are clean people.
- **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES.** The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of animals in distress.

Turn left on Jackson Road and proceed 7.1 miles to Lone Pine Rd. Turn right on Lone Pine. Murieta Equestrian Center is immediately on your right.

- Novice B Large Dog (20,24)
- Novice Preferred Small Dog (4p, 8p, 12p)

Winners will be calculated by cumulative time under course time for qualifying runs in Standard, JWW and T2B on Thursday, December 29; Friday, December 30; and Saturday, December 31 (9 classes total).

If a run is qualifying but not clean, the points from that run will be reduced based on your score (a score of 95 rather than 10 will mean you get 95% of the time under course time rather than 100% for that run). If a run is clean but overtime, you will get a "zero" for that run.

Scores will be input as class results as approved by the judges. Intermediate results will be posted at the end of each day.

Awards will be presented at the end of Time 2 Beat on Saturday, December 31, and re-announced during the morning briefing on Sunday, Jan 1. **Please be present to collect your award or arrange for someone to pick it up for you.**

Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program<sup>SM</sup>** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
