



Thank you for entering our USDAA Agility trial to be held at the Yolo County Fairgrounds on June 13-15, 2014. Please read your confirmation carefully. Move ups are accepted until 6PM on Wednesday, June 11 2014. If you have anything to change, mail Karey Krauter at [kkrauter@bumpsays.com](mailto:kkrauter@bumpsays.com) or call 650-906-5146.

There are about 400 runs each day (less on Friday, more on Saturday) with 70 Masters dogs entered, 10 Advanced dogs and 20 Starters dogs entered so we should end at a reasonable time both days. 9 teams and 8 PVP's (at the moment).

Important Note to exhibitors: We must clean-up and bag all poop (it is in the contract - we will be fined if this is not done). Also do not allow dogs to urinate on trash cans or ANY structure!!!

**FOOD:** On-The-Scene Cuisine will be on-site all three days providing awesome morning and lunch eatables! Each ring's Crew Chief will provide workers with a lunch ticket. If you plan to work after lunch, be sure to track down your Crew Chief in the morning and ask for your ticket!

**SATURDAY DINNER!** On-The-Scene Cuisine will be serving dinner on-site Saturday evening, available to all takers who PRE-ORDER with me in advance. If you want to check your score while your jump height is still running, feel free to peek over our shoulders, but please try to be quick about it and then move off so others can peek. While it's true the score table is busy, we are never too busy to help you.

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

**East on Interstate 80:** Interstate 80 East to Woodland off ramp (Hwy.113). Take Gibson Rd. turn off. Turn left onto Gibson Rd. At Matmor signal turn right. Go to Gum Ave. (stop sign). Turn left onto Gum Avenue and, proceed west to main entrance of fair.

**South on Interstate 5:** Interstate 5 take Hwy. 113 (Main Street). Stay on 113 and take Gibson Road turn off. Turn right at Matmor signal and go to Gum Ave. Turn left onto Gum and proceed west to the main entrance.

**North on Interstate 5:** Take Interstate 5 North and take the E. Main Hwy 113 off ramp, turn left and follow E. Main street thru town. Turn left on East Street. Go to Gum Ave. and turn left. Go through the front entrance of the fairgrounds.

#### **THURSDAY SET UP: 1:00PM, 2:00PM**

Ring set-up starts Thursday at 2PM. Competitors are very welcome to come then and help set up AND get preferential crating treatment!

General competitor set up starts at 1PM. We're hoping that if you come and get yourself set up early then you'll have nothing better to do than help ring set-up at 2PM!! NOTE nothing can be staked down in the ring area until after the rings are laid out.

Be aware that the fairground gates will NOT be locked at any time, and the competitor assumes all risk of leaving items overnight. TRACS will not be responsible for any loss or damage to items at the show site.

**RV PARKING** - Is by advance arrangement \$25 per night with hookups, \$5 without, honor system. If you didn't send in an RV form with your entry form but wish to RV now, contact [kkrauter@bumpsays.com](mailto:kkrauter@bumpsays.com).

**RV's can arrive and set up at 1PM.** When you arrive, check in with Susan Cochran for the permit you are required to display on your dashboard. RV spots are first-come-first-served, with the exception of some marked spots that will be reserved for key workers. If you want to RV with your friends, make your own arrangements to have the first arrived in your group save adjacent spots for the rest of your crowd.

**DAY PARKING** - Parking is allowed in the interior of the fairgrounds. You will be directed AWAY from designated RV spots: please be considerate! Further, anyone parked inside may NOT MOVE THEIR VEHICLE while the trial is running (approximately between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.). If you anticipate needing to move your vehicle during these hours, you should instead park in the main parking lot outside the fairgrounds front gate.


