

COVID-19 STATEMENT

AS OF Mar 23, 2020

The TRACS Board is watching guidance/orders from the Governor and the CDC/WHO. We will make a determination no later than May 1 as to whether our May AKC Memorial Day trials will be held.

At this time, TRACS is accepting entries for our Memorial Day agility trials, May 22 – 25, 2020.

If it does go forward, we are going to keep it very basic this year: just our basic slate of classes, the WTT ISC Classes, and the Parade of Veterans. All additional programs have been postponed until next year.

If we do cancel, **ALL entries fees will be fully refunded**, provided you have not entered online (the AKC online entry system will not refund the online convenience fees). Any certificates sent with entries will be returned/reissued.

Additionally, in the event of trial cancellation: for those who have entered the Parade of Veterans, TRACS is still going to order/send you your dog's PoV Rosette.

So, with that in mind, if you are going to send an entry, please do it sooner than later, so that in the event we can have the trial, your Trial Secretary will not have to try and process a flood of entries at the last minute.

All entry fee checks will be held until a final decision is made.

With regard to those of you making RV reservations: we are NOT accepting PayPal payments for RV reservations for this show due to the difficulty and costs involved with refunds. Please send a check with your RV reservations.

ENTRY METHOD: FIRST RECEIVED

No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after opening. **Online entry available through the AKC online Entry System!**

ENTRIES WILL OPEN ON MONDAY, MARCH 16, 2020 at 9:00 am at the Trial Secretary's address. All entries received before this date will be returned. Overnight or certified mail must be sent with the "No Signature Required" waiver signed.

ENTRIES CLOSE ON FRIDAY, MAY 8, 2020 at 11:30 pm after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. **THIS INCLUDES DOGS JUMPING 24"**. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include the dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

IMPORTANT NOTE TO EXHIBITORS

- If you provide an email address on your entry form, all future communications will be via email, including final confirmation information and judging schedule. Please make sure the Trial Secretary's email address: (kathie@touchngoagility.com) is allowed by your spam blocker. We will not resend or do any extra work to get your ISP to allow us to send messages to your email address.
- **Move ups** will be accepted until **Monday, May 18, 2020 at 6 pm**. Day to day move ups will be accepted providing a move up form is completed and turned into the Trial Secretary on site within **15 minutes** of the last run of each day, but DON'T Wait!! You can turn in your move up as soon as the official results are posted. It really helps us out to get the move ups earlier in the day.

ENTRY FEES

Daily Entry Fees (per dog): \$21.00 - 1st Class / \$15.00 each additional class; ISC Classes - \$10.00 All fees must be paid in U.S. funds only-by cash or check.

JUNIOR HANDLER DISCOUNT!

ONLINE vs PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS:

TRACS is accepting Online entries for this trial through AKC Agility Online Entry Service. Go to www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper entries will be as follows: All days: Online Entry, 200 per day; Paper entries: 500. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or the paper limits accordingly.

AKC ONLINE ENTRY REFUND POLICY: **AKC Online convenience fees will not be refunded for any reason.**

SHOW SITE: This show will be held outdoors on grass. All rings will be 130' long by 100' wide.

The AKC World Team needs your support

Each year the AKC selects and sends a team of 12 dogs to represent the United States of America at the Agility World Championship Competition. This year the event will be in Finland! The AKC provides funding for the team to practice and to travel to Europe. The skyrocketing cost of travel and the weak dollar have increased these expenses dramatically.

You can help the AKC / USA World Agility Team by choosing to donate \$1 (or more if you choose to) in addition to the normal entry fee for this show. This donation will be collected and sent directly to the Team Leader (Carrie DeYoung, AKC Agility Director) and will be credited to the AKC / USA World Agility Team Account

AWARDS

- Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs with qualifying scores in each regular and preferred class and jump height.
- Prizes valued between \$2 and \$5 will be awarded to all dogs placing first through fourth in their class/jump height.
- Green Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score.
- Special Rosettes will be awarded to any dog completing a title
- Special pins will be awarded to any dog earning a "Double Q (Std/JWW)" or "Triple Q (Std/JWW/FAST)" from the Master classes.
- Special Award for any dog completing a **MACH/PACH/AGCH**. **PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary if you anticipate you may complete your MACH/PACH/AGCH at our trial. Otherwise we may not have enough rosettes to give to everyone!**
- ISC – rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs with qualifying scores in each jump height plus a prize for 1st place. In addition, a cash prize will be awarded to the dog with the best combined score from each jump height in the ISC Standard and ISC JWW Classes.
- SPECIAL AWARDS: TRACS is offering a variety of special awards that are open to ALL exhibitors. Please see the notice later in this premium for full details.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC): This class is now open to dogs competing at any AKC level!!

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend –

Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, clubs holding agility trials will be **required to offer Fix and Go On for all classes**. Fix and Go On is being offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to the expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather it occurs during the course of the run.

THE RULES:

1. The handler may reset the dog and repeat one obstacle ONE time to attempt to fix a behavior. Handlers may include preceding obstacles to establish a proper approach to the obstacle being fixed.
2. Handlers can touch equipment, re-set a jump, and touch / pet their dog.
3. Should a handler attempt to fix an additional obstacle and/or behavior later in the course, the whistle will be blown, and the handler must immediately proceed to the exit.
4. Handlers may choose to fix a start line.
 - a. This is not to be confused with a handler who runs with their dog after their initial return.
 - b. Judges will signal FNG when the handler LEADS OUT past the first obstacle the SECOND TIME.
 - c. The Timer will manually start the time when the judge signals FNG.
5. If the dog breaks their start line and completes the first obstacle and the handler chooses to repeat the lead out, the judge will signal FNG when the handler directs their dog back to the start. The time will continue to run.
6. FNG should be utilized for the benefit of the dog to reinforce a positive performance and NOT as a punitive correction. Hard verbal and/or physical correction shall not be tolerated and results in immediate dismissal from the ring.

FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

TRACS is offering FEO for all FAST & T2B Classes

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. **Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.**
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time
- FEO Course time: Normal programmed time for T2B and FAST.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Wait List: Two Rivers Agility Club of Sacramento is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials closing date. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 11:00 pm on May 8, 2020. Any entries withdrawn that have been received by 11:30 pm on May 8, 2020 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund **less a \$5 processing fee will be issued to the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on Monday, May 18, 2020 will receive a full refund.**

- This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.
- Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.
- Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.
- Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and must list "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) for the breed name on the entry form. No other breed description may be used to identify a mixed breed entry. Additionally, the exhibitor must provide their AKC Canine Partners listing number on the entry form and check-mark "AKC No."
- Running order will be determined by a random draw. Handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope.
- **There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or handler or bitches in season. In the case of injury, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified in writing prior to the trial. The club reserves the right to ask for a doctor's or vet's note in the event of a request for refund.**

- **With the exception of any online entry convenience fees, in the event of a bitch coming into season after closing, full entry fees will be refunded.**
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- No entry fee will be refunded if this trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry-PLEASE PRINT or use the entry forms fillable .pdf function;** illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial.
- **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.** The Trial Secretary will add a **\$25.00 collection fee** to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a “cash only” basis.
- Handlers of all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog, prior to the start of a class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring. There will not be equipment familiarization at this trial. No umbrellas permitted on course during walk throughs.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fee paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors, while competing, must wear appropriate/proper footwear. For safety reasons, exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in “bare” feet or open toe shoes.
- Please clean up after your dog. Let’s show them that “Dog People” are clean people.
- **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES.** The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of animals in distress.
- On Call Veterinarian: UC Davis Veterinary Teaching Hospital (530) 752-1393. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

AGILITY TRIAL SITE DIRECTIONS AND ACCOMMODATIONS

DIRECTIONS:

From Sacramento: Take I-80 west towards Dixon. Exit at Hwy 113 south towards Dixon. Stay straight as the road curves left over I-80, following the signs to stay on Hwy 113-S. Hwy 113 becomes First Street. Follow First St for a couple of miles, passing through downtown Dixon. The fairgrounds are three blocks past downtown on your left.

From Bay Area: Take Hwy I-80 east towards Sacramento. Exit at the Dixon Avenue/A Street and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are three blocks south on your left.

FOR ALL: Once you see the fairgrounds, go past the office and main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds. The agility site will be clearly in view as you enter the fairgrounds.

RV PARKING/Tent Camping/Dry Camping: Is by advance reservation ONLY! All RV parking, Tent/Car Camping or Dry camping reservations must be made by sending in the enclosed form to Karey Krauter (address is on the form later in the Premium List) and **ALL overnights will be given an ASSIGNED parking/camping spot.** Space is limited.

RVs/Campers arriving after 7:30 am on Friday will not be parked until after the end of the last class of the day. After 7:30 am, RVs MUST park in the outer lot on First Street, across from the main entrance of the Fairgrounds.

INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES – AKC World Team Tryouts Qualifier

ISC Combined Class Winners: Combined scores from ISC Jumpers and Standard classes at this event will be used to award the Combined ISC Class Award. To be eligible for the Combined ISC Class Award the team must have a minimum of one clean ISC run and a run that has a maximum of 5 course faults (no time faults allowed) for those scores to be used to compute the Combined Score. The Combined Class winner from the 12, 16 and 24 inch height is invited to attend AKC World Team Tryouts. They do not need to fulfill the requirement of the 6/6 scores. The team must also send in all the required information with the fees and the entry form and meet all the other basic eligibility (including an approved pedigree). The handler at tryouts must be the same handler that won the combined award.

Purpose of the International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is to provide the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: This class is open all dogs eligible to compete in AKC Agility competitions. **There is no Preferred Option for ISC;** dogs may enter at their preferred jump height; however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.

Jump Heights: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump height, however, only those dogs in the 12" & 16" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs), or any dog entering the 24" or 24C jump height will be eligible for the direct invitation to the 2020 World Team Tryouts.

Small (12" jump height) – for dogs measuring 13 ¾" and/or less at the withers
Medium (16" jump height) – for dogs measuring over 13 ¾" but 16 7/8" or less
Large (24" jump height) – for dog measuring over 16 7/8"

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: PREMIER STANDARD AND JWW:

PURPOSE: These optional titling classes are designed to challenge dogs and handlers at an increased speed and skill level above those set for the Master level classes. Handlers/dogs will need to negotiate courses that required varied approach angles, spacing and obstacle discriminations to be successful in these classes. These classes are offered as separate titling tracks and are not part of the MACH/PACH Championships, however, these classes ARE part of the AGILITY GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP title as well as they can be used to fulfill some AKC Nationals Qualifying requirements.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: All dogs, regardless of regular class level, are eligible to enter both Premier Standard and Premier JWW.

HEIGHT DIVISION CHART

Exhibitors may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately. Dogs measuring over 22" at the shoulder are not eligible to enter 24" Choice.
