Closing Date: Entries will be accepted until 6:00 PM on Thursday, January 26, 2006 after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted

Entry is limited to five (5) dogs with an AKC TD or TDX title.

Entry Fee: \$90.00 payable in US dollars (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee and \$1.50 Event Fee). Make checks payable to TRACS.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

Draw for Entry: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing time and date to determine which entries will participate in the test will take place on Thursday, January 26, 2006 at 6:15 PM at Wenelli's Pizza, 4215 Arden Way, Sacramento, CA.

Alternate list: An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries that are to run.

Notification: Notification of the draw results will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary.

Refund policy: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

Draw for running order: All entrants must be at the test site by **8:35 AM** the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place. The test secretary will have her cell phone turned on at the test site: (916) 616-3887

Test hours: 5:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. **Judging will begin** as soon as tracks have sufficiently aged.

Awards: A dark green qualifying ribbon and a rosette personalized with the dogs name will be awarded to each passing dog.

Dogs on leash: Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

Bitches in season may participate: If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the test, notify the test secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.

Dogs in vehicles: Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the sponsoring club for disciplinary action. All persons attending this test hereby waive any claim for damages against TRACS or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
