**Closing Date:** Entries will be accepted until 5:15 PM on Thursday, October 21, 2010, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted

**Entry is limited to five (5) dogs.**

**Entry Fee:** \$125.00 payable in US dollars (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee & \$3.00 event fee). Make checks payable to TRACS.

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**

**Exhibitors** should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

**Draw for Entry:** A random drawing of all entries received by the closing time and date to determine which entries will participate in the test will take place on Thursday, October 21, 2010 at 5:30 PM at Wenelli's Pizza, located at 4215 Arden Way, Sacramento, CA.

**Alternate list:** An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries that are to run.

**Notification:** Notification of the draw results will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary.

**Refund policy:** The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

**Draw for running order:** All entrants must be at the test site by **9:45 AM** the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

**Test hours:** 5:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. **Judging will begin** as soon as tracks have sufficiently aged.

**Awards:** A dark green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each passing dog.

**Dogs on leash:** Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

**Bitches in season may participate:** If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the test, notify the test secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.

**Dogs in vehicles:** Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the sponsoring club for disciplinary action. All persons attending this test hereby waive any claim for damages against TRACS or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., Over 13 in. But not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
