Closing Date: Entries will be accepted until 5:00 PM on Thursday, January 20, 2011 after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

Entry Fee: \$100.00. A \$50 recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee is included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per CH 11, Sec. 2 of the AKC Rules and Regulations. Make checks payable to TRACS.

Tracking Test Entries: Dogs holding the title of Tracking Dog Excellent shall not be barred from competition; however, dogs not having a TDX will be given preference by the Test Secretary. Entries are limited to 5 dogs.

The Draw: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing time and date to determine which entries will participate in the test will take place on Thursday, January 20, 2011 at 6:00 PM, Tuppelo Coffee House and Roasting Company, 5700 Elvas Ave., Sacramento, CA 95819.

Alternate List: An alternate list will be created and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries which are to run.

Notification: Notification of the draw results will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary.

Please Note: Entrant will be notified by e-mail or phone immediately upon receipt of entry. *If you have not heard from the test secretary, there is a good chance your entry was not received.* Please feel free to check with test secretary before the closing date.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Refund policy: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified of entry withdrawal prior to the draw and an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

Bitches in season may participate: If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the test, notify the test secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.

Draw for running order: All entrants must be at the test site by 9:00 AM the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

Judging will begin as soon as tracks have sufficiently aged.

Awards: A dark green qualifying ribbon and a rosette will be awarded to each passing team, as well as the articles on the track.

Dogs on leash: TRACS requests that all dogs and bitches entered in this test be kept on leash at all times. This also applies to any non-entered dogs that may accompany anyone at this test.

Event Cancellation: TRACS may cancel the event in extreme weather conditions. The safety of both the exhibitor and the dogs is paramount in making this decision.

Directions to test site: **From Sacramento** take Hwy 50 towards Placerville. Take Sunrise Blvd. South exit and go 4 miles to Douglas Rd. Turn right on Douglas Rd. and go 1 mile to Eagles Nest Rd. Turn left on Eagles Nest Rd. Go 2/10 mile and turn left into Mather Field Rotary Park where we will meet for the draw. **From Placerville** take Hwy 50 towards Sacramento and follow the above directions.

Practicing is allowed in the fields. The areas we are allowed to use are anything on the right after you turn onto Eagles Nest all the way to Woodring Rd. and anything on the left past the golf course. Please do not use the area on the right beyond Woodring as dogs are no longer allowed in that area.

Veterinarian on Call: Sacramento Animal Medical Group. will be the on-call emergency veterinary hospital – 4990 Manzanita Avenue, Carmichael, CA 95608 (916) 331-7430.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Test Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending this test hereby waive any claim for damages against TRACS or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
